**Iowa – AFCT 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary**



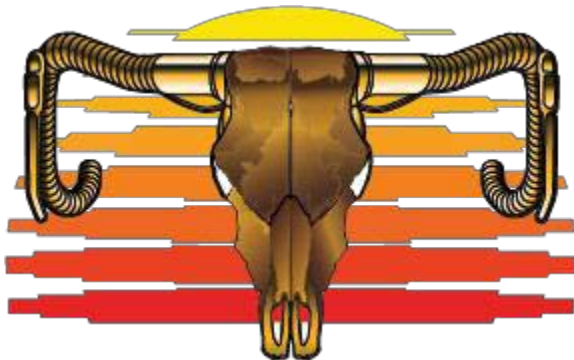
Ride across Iowa

**August:**

**12. August 24<sup>th</sup> – Hotter’n Hell Hundred (Ride Marshall Duties—Max Participation)**

## September:

### **13. September 14<sup>th</sup> – Conquer the Coast** **Corpus Christi Bay, Texas (2.5 hours from San Antonio)**



Here, your adventure has only begun as you continue to make your way through all the quirky little towns in between that line the shores of Corpus Christi Bay. Portland, Aransas Pass, Ingleside and Port Aransas all offer their own unique flair to the Coastal Bend and promise spectacular views along the way. The Port Aransas Ferry connects you to Mustang & Padre Island where the true test begins. Some call it the “Toughest 18 Miles in Texas” as this stretch of Mustang Island is what it’s all about. It’s what separates the joy riders from the cyclists. A quick jump across the Intercoastal Waterway and you hit Ocean Drive. Easily one of the most scenic drives in all of Texas. Route Distances: 10 mile, 21 mile, and 66 mile.
